**BE RIGHT—By being on the right side of God's story.**

**We have to be careful, however, that our character defects aren't about us living on the wrong side of God's story.**

**Esther 3:9-14**

"What did we do for Mordecai for saving me?"

**Esther 6:4-14**

"An adversary and enemy! This vile Haman!"

**"Will he even molest the queen while she is with me in the house?"**
